Meetings and letters sent to both State and Federal Governments and Central Coast Council have been vigorous as with the organising of Guest Speakers at our General Meetings.

- **EPA Rail Freight Noise fines on Freight Companies due to be ratified.**
- **RMS - Word has it you may be interested to know that the new traffic lights at the intersection of Koolinda /Jirrah Avenues and Brisbane Water Drive are planned to be operational by June 2020.**
- **Central Coast Council is continuing Road maintenance throughout the area including Glenrock Parade.**
- **Meeting of concerned Community Residents held at Point Clare Community Hall re a DA for 34-36 Brisbane Water Drive Koolewong opposite Koolewong Station beside Couche Park for a block of 15 Units 4-5 storeys in height with residents submissions sent to Central Coast Council.**
- **Wendy Drive Point Clare children's sensory playground restoration by Central Coast Council is now in play.**
- **Brisbane Water Foreshore Reserve Pontoon Noise at Tascott has been resolved thanks to Central Coast Council.**
- **The Bush Care Group in conjunction with Central Coast Council is active in Goodaywang Reserve and meets every 3rd Saturday of the Month weather permitting.**
- **Point Clare Community Hall, Community Garden along with Lawn Maintenance is flourishing. New budding gardeners are most welcome.**
- **The success of our Meet the Candidates Forums held in Point Clare Community Hall shortly before the NSW State and Federal Elections.**
- **Request to NSW Transport for disabled access for Point Clare-Tascott and Koolewong Rail Stations is an ongoing issue.**
